

General Certificate of Conformity

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In accordance with Section 14 of the Consumer Product Safety Act, Foss Manufacturing Company, LLC states that the following products do not exceed the lead or phthalate content limits under sections 101 and 108 of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA).

Fosshield Baby Blankets

Under the current Consumer Product Safety Commission Statement of Policy, textiles made from common synthetic fibers such as polyester, olefins, acrylic, and nylon do not normally contain and are not expected to contain phthalates and are exempt from testing requirements.

16 CFR Section 1500.91 Determinations regarding lead content for certain materials or products under section 101 of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act(d) states:

“The following materials do not exceed the lead content limits under section 101(a) of the CPSIA provided that these materials have neither been treated or adulterated with the addition of materials that could result in the addition of lead into the product or material:

(7) Textiles consisting of:

(ii) Manufactured fibers (dyed or undyed) including, but not limited to, rayon, azlon, lyocell, acetate, triacetate, rubber, polyester, olefin, nylon, acrylic, modacrylic, aramid, spandex.”

The products listed above are made entirely from or entirely from a combination of acrylic, olefin and polyester and are not treated or adulterated with the addition of materials that could result in the addition of lead or phthalates into them and are exempt from testing requirements under CPSIA.

The use of these products by another manufacturer in a product may generate cause for further testing under CPSIA and other regulations. This further testing and any Certificate of Conformity required by such use are the sole responsibility of that manufacturer.
